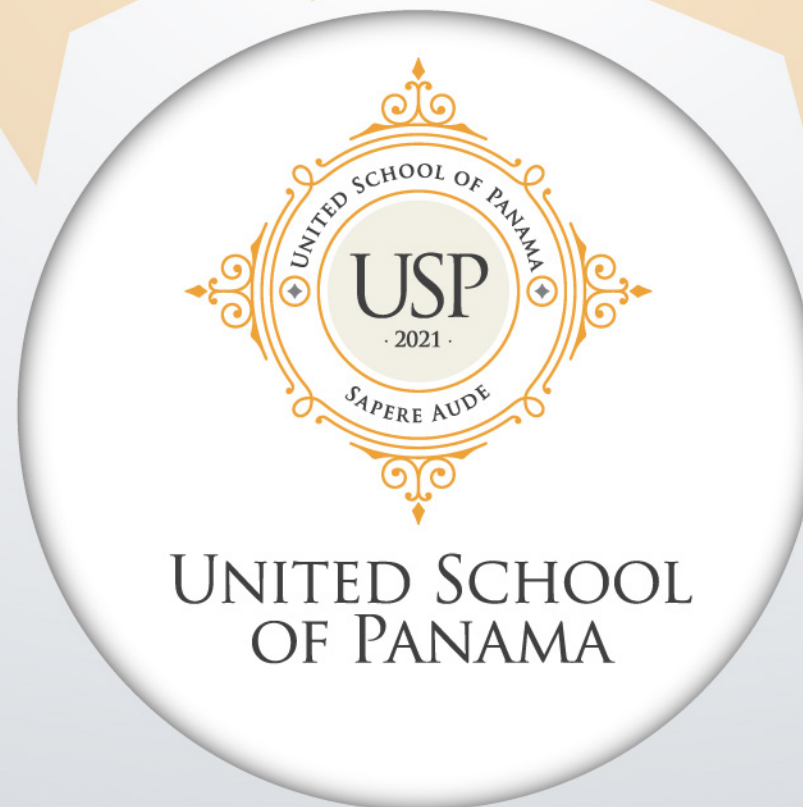

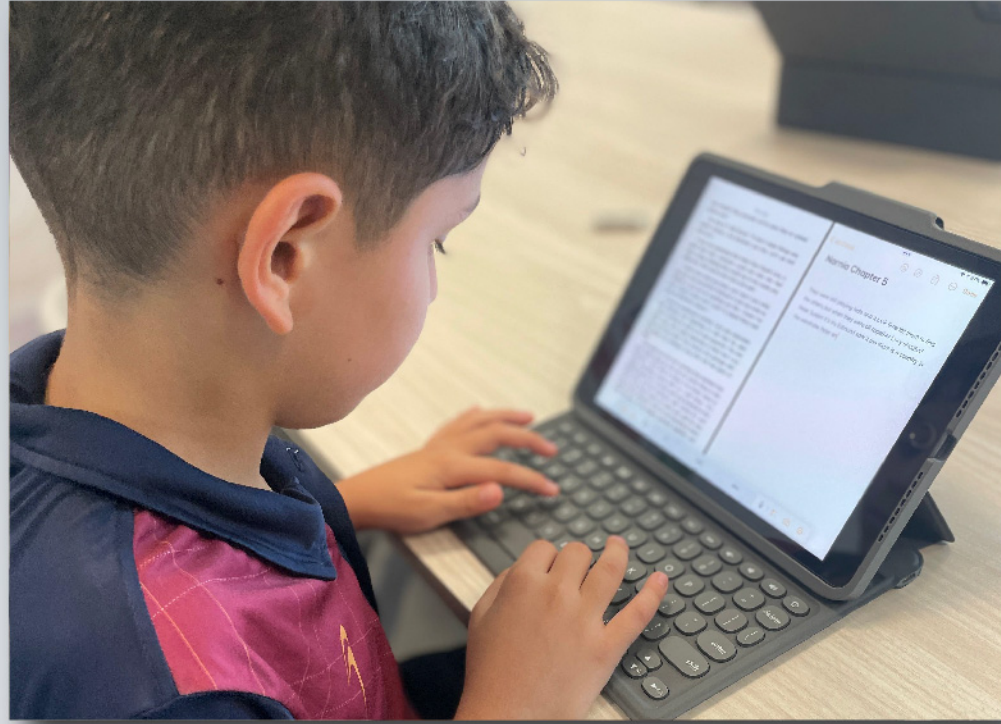


Model Head + Heart + Hands

Computer Science Program

CODE.org is the first Computational Science program that seeks to join the current education system. The Syllabus was written taking into account the standards of the K-12 Computer Science Framework and the Computer Science Teachers Association (CSTA).

The Syllabus is reviewed every two years with the intention of keeping it updated with computer advances.

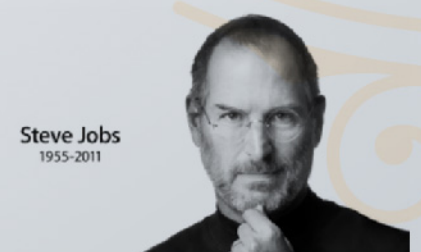
What skills does it develop in children?
